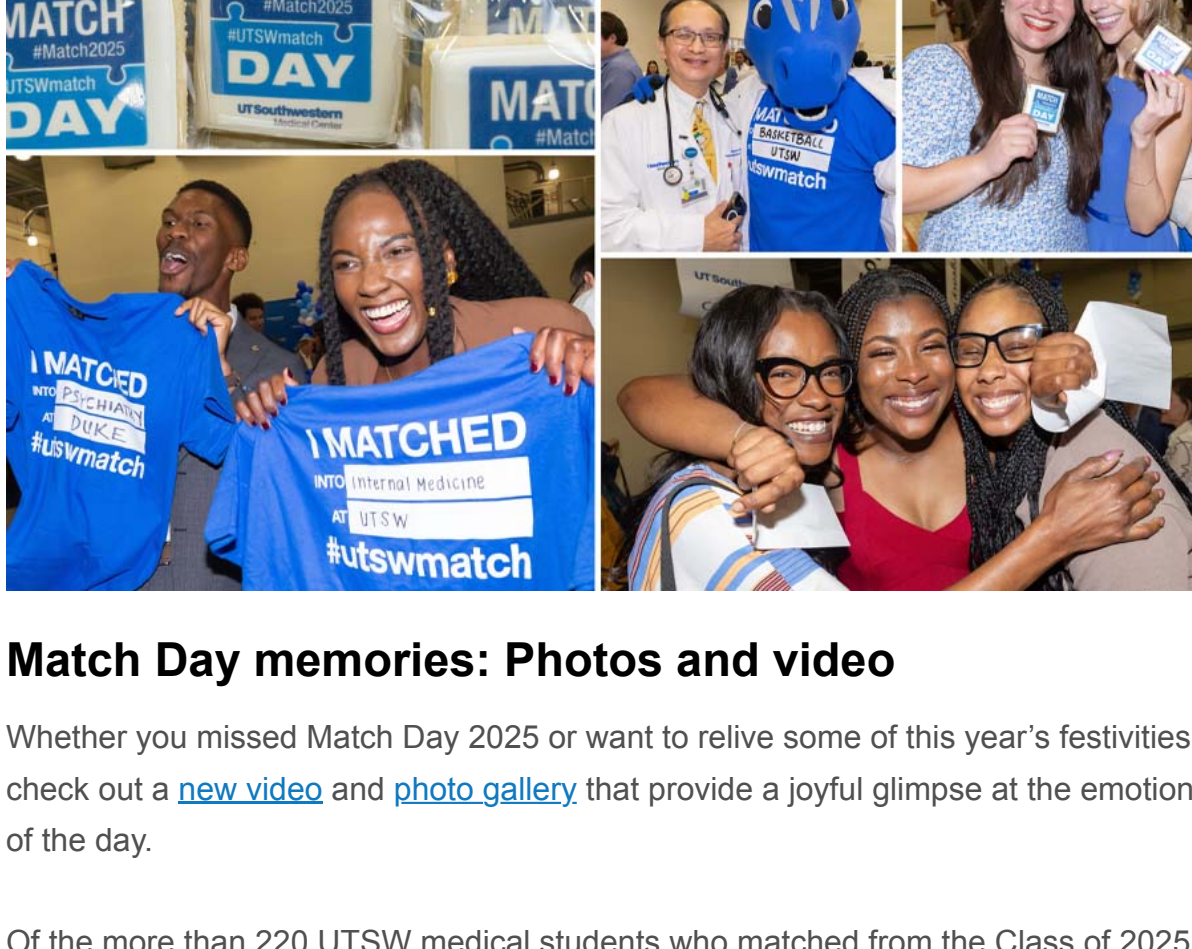




Match Day memories: Photos and video

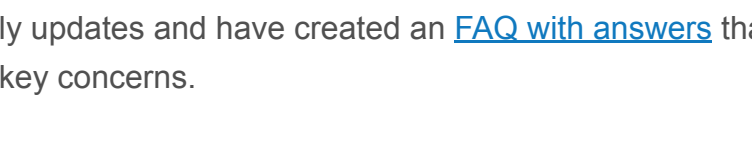

Blue Cross Blue Shield negotiations continue

Yesterday, the campus community [received a message](#) regarding the status of ongoing negotiations between Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) and Southwestern Health Resources (SWHR).

We recognize that many of you have questions about how the negotiations may impact you and your family's medical coverage. Health System leaders are working to provide timely updates and have created an [FAQ with answers](#) that should address some key concerns.

Exploring the possibility of lab-grown organs

Researchers have successfully steered stem cells in the lab to form many cell and tissue types, but generating whole organs has remained a challenge, partly due to a lack of understanding about how tubular parts form, connect, and are maintained. Solving that mystery could potentially pave the way for lab-grown organs, addressing the critical donor shortage.

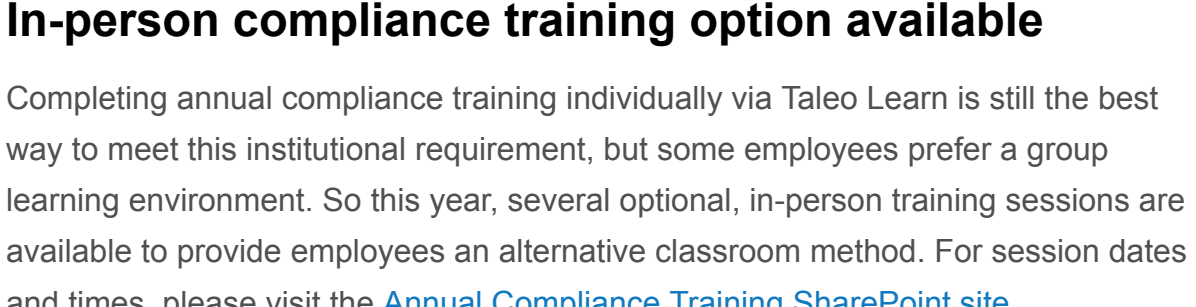
Onndine Cleaver, Ph.D., Professor of Molecular Biology, has dedicated her career to unraveling this challenge. She will share her lab's insights at the next President's Lecture on Thursday, April 24, at 4 p.m. in her talk, "From Tubes to Tissues: The Cellular Choreography of Organ Formation."

The event will be held in the Tom and Lula Gooch Auditorium on South Campus, with a reception to follow. It will also be livestreamed.

In-person compliance training option available

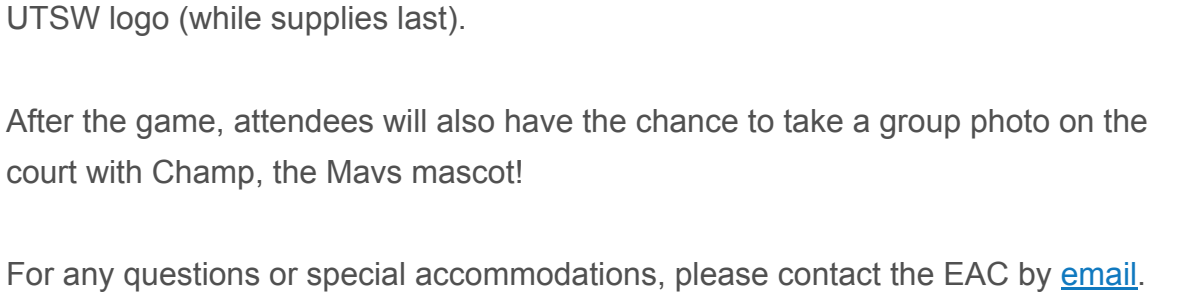

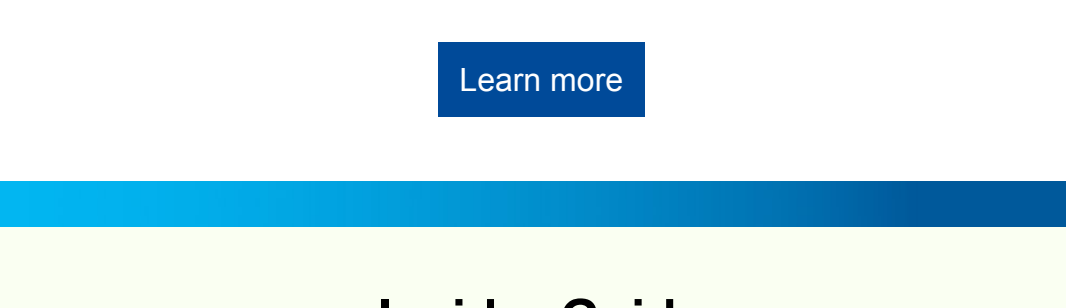


Build better habits with Healthier U Club

Researchers, clinicians, educators, students, and administrators from across the UT system are invited to submit their abstracts on the diverse applications of AI.

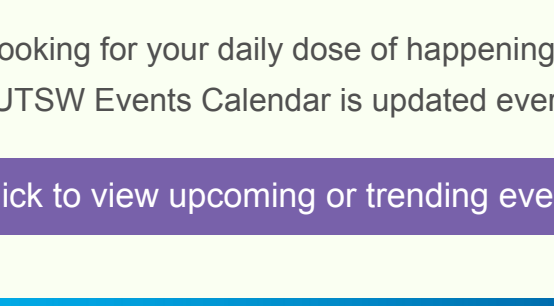
Abstracts are due April 11.
