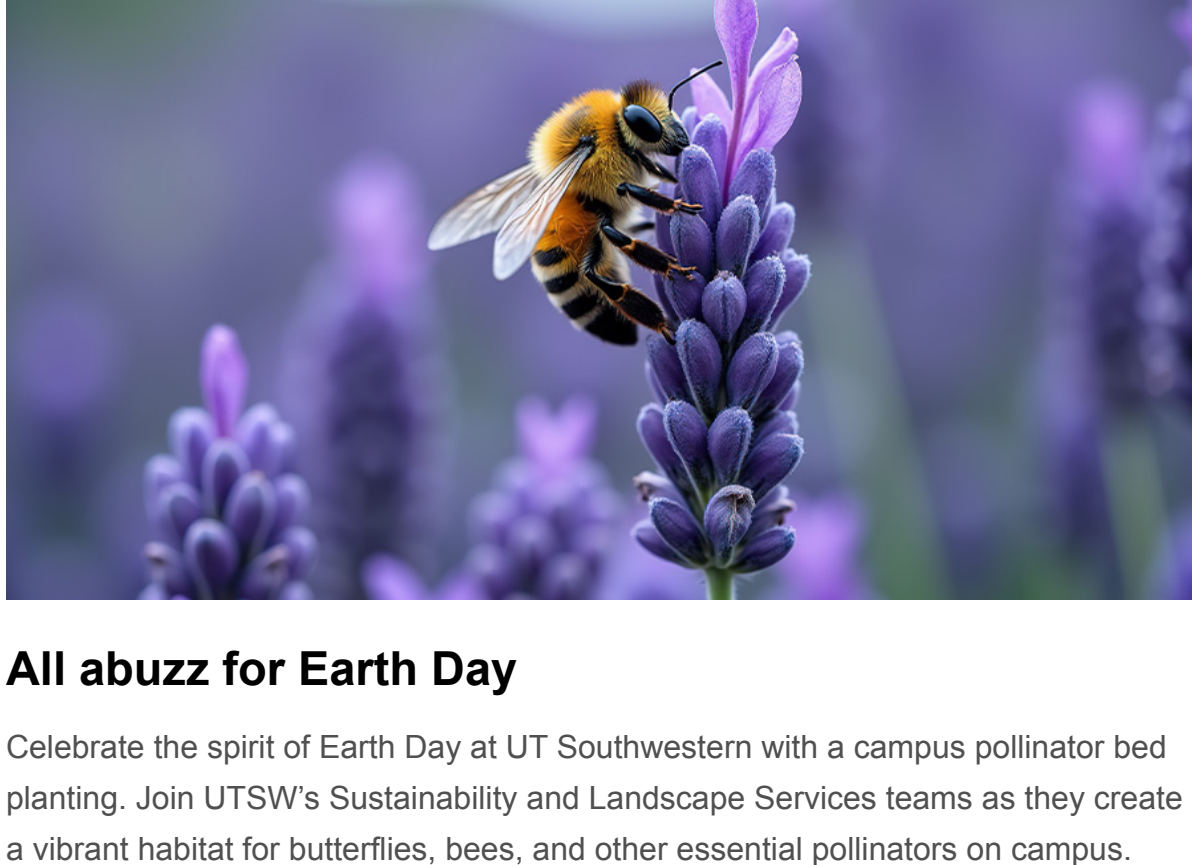




All abuzz for Earth Day

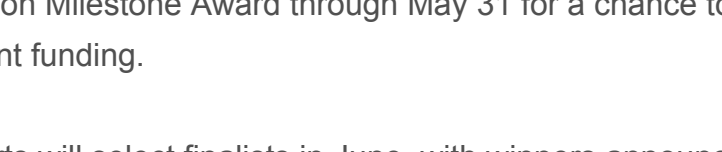

Milestone Award to offer funding support

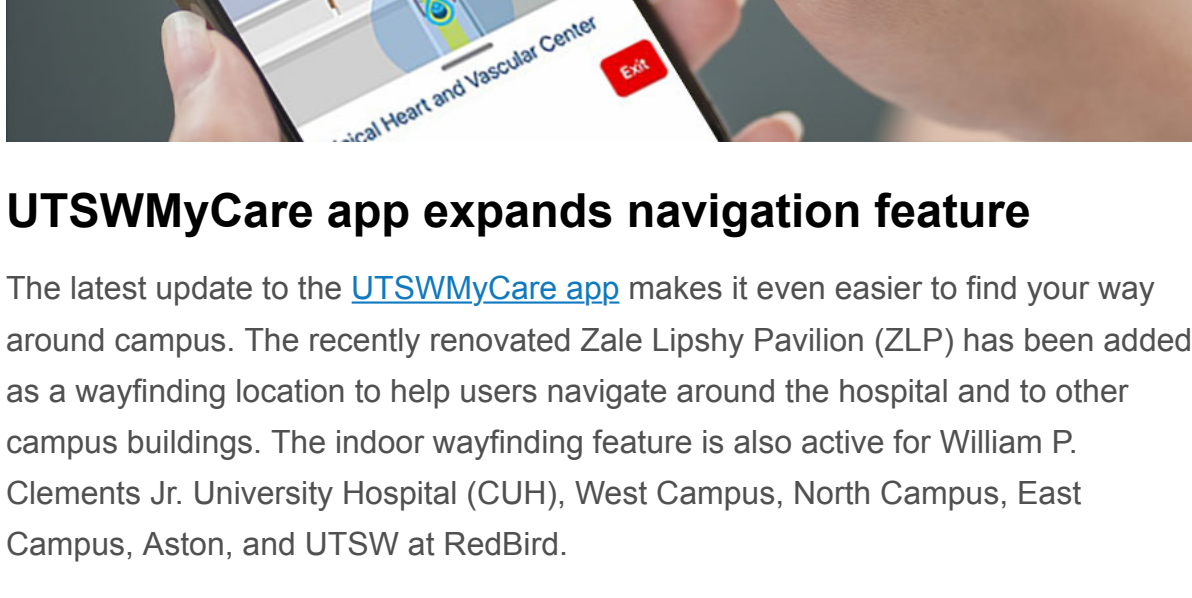

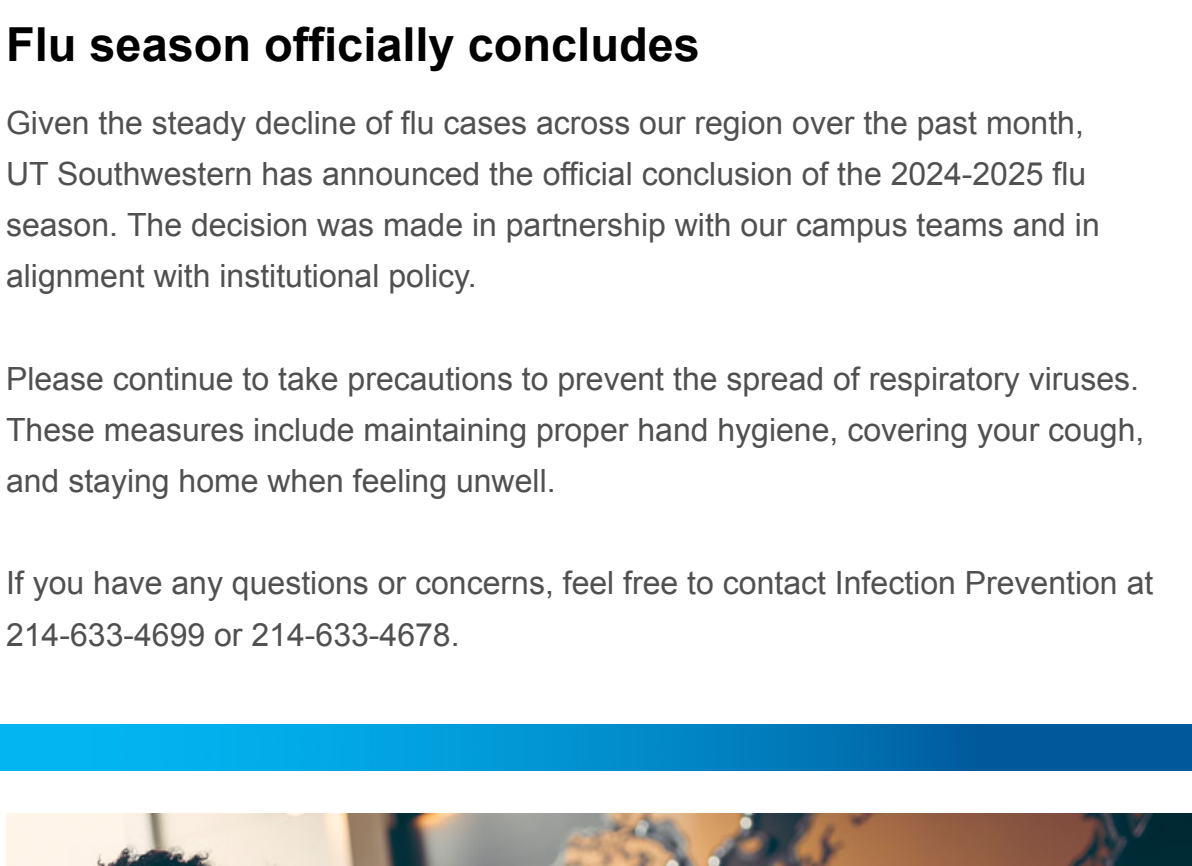
UTSWMyCare app expands navigation feature

The latest update to the [UTSWMyCare app](#) makes it even easier to find your way around campus. The recently renovated Zale Lipshy Pavilion (ZLP) has been added as a wayfinding location to help users navigate around the hospital and to other campus buildings. The indoor wayfinding feature is also active for William P. Clements Jr. University Hospital (CUH), West Campus, North Campus, East Campus, Aston, and UTSW at RedBird.

MyCare provides an additional resource for both staff and patients to engage with the campus. Patients can launch video visits through the app, find specialists, search for the nearest preferred clinic, and connect to rideshare apps. In addition, MyChart is fully embedded, making it easy to message a provider, access test results, make appointments, request prescription refills, and manage billing – all through MyCare.

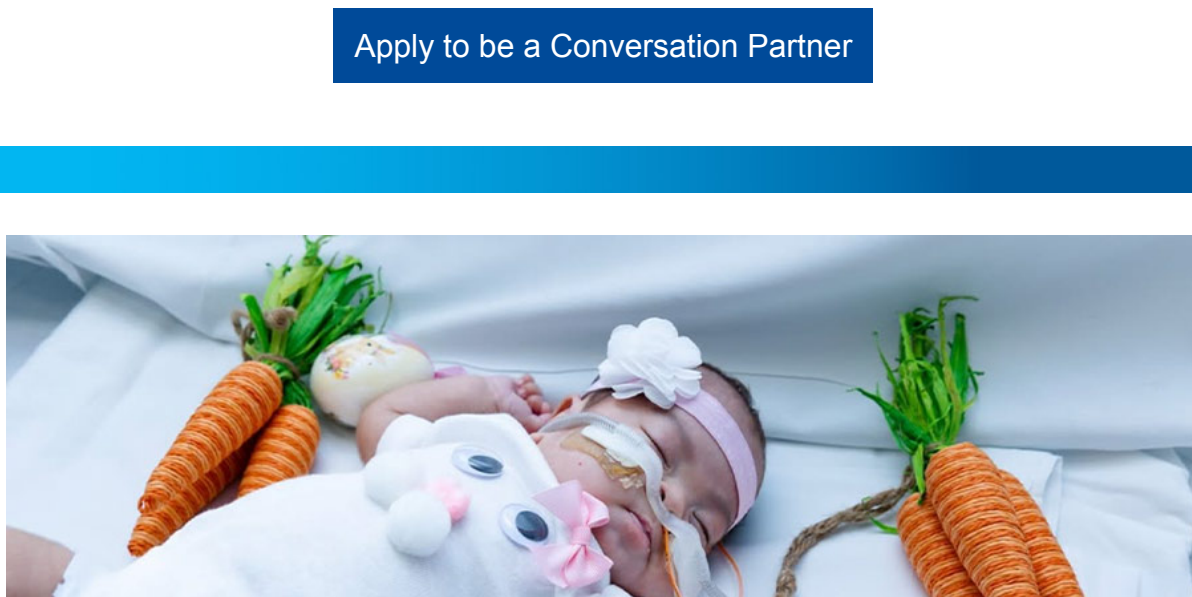


Flu season officially concludes

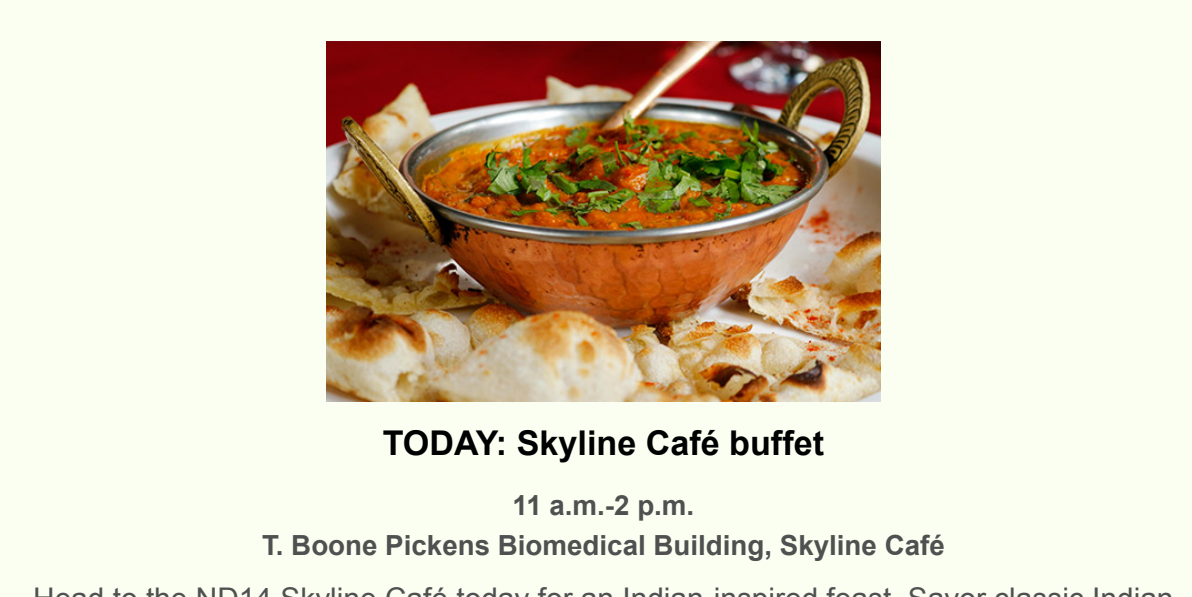
Hopping into spring

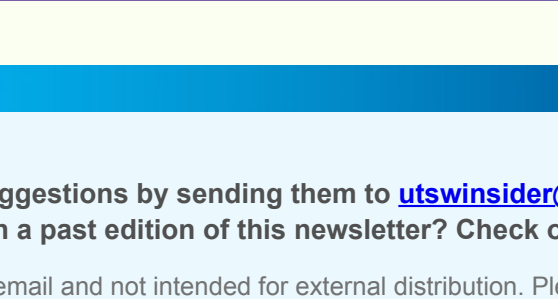

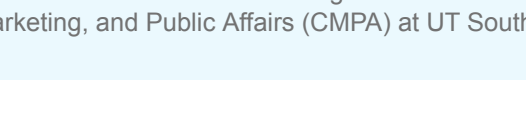

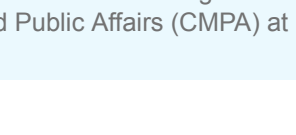
