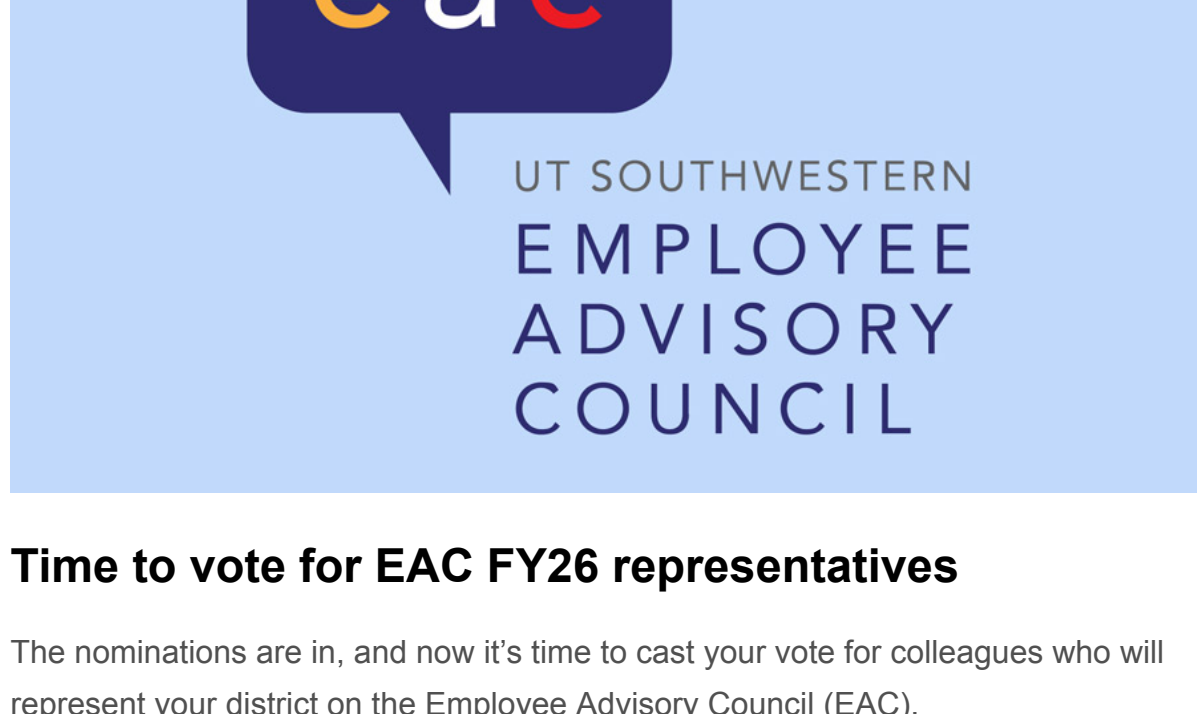
Inside the minds of UTSW's newest research leaders

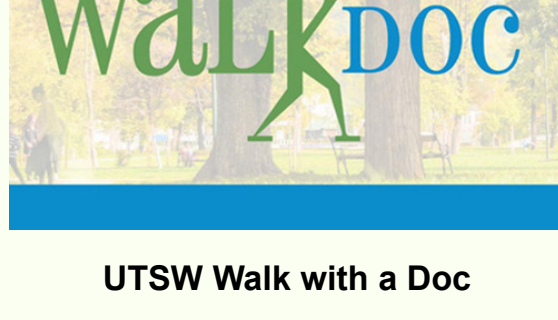
TODAY: Music from the DSO

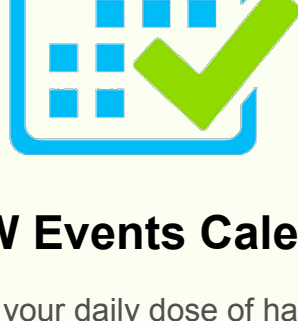
UTSW Walk with a Doc
